WHEREAS, The Mayfield Town Council finds it necessary to review and possibly update our zoning ordinance.

WHEREAS, The Town Council finds that previous lot splits have left parcels of land in Town under our required minimum lot size of 20,000 square feet.

WHEREAS, The Town Council finds that these smaller lot sizes do not comply with our current zoning ordinance.

WHEREAS, The Town Council feels the need to create a moratorium on any lot splitting in Mayfield Town boundaries for 6 months while the zoning ordinance is reviewed.

NOW THEREFORE, The Town Council hereby resolves as follows:

- 1. Definition: The following term is defined for the purpose of this resolution:
 - (a) "Moratorium" means a temporary prohibition of an activity.
- 2. The Town issues a moratorium on any lots being split.
- 3. Once the Town Planning Commission has been able to propose an update to our current zoning ordinance, this moratorium will be reviewed.
- 4. This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the Town Council.
