## <u>Mayfield Town</u> Ordinance #2017-18 -1

AN ORDINANCE OF MAYFIELD TOWN, UTAH AMENDING THE MAYFIELD TOWN ZONING ORDINANCE SECTION 10-5-6.3 #6B TO AMEND AND LIMIT THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ANIMAL UNITS ALLOW WITHIN THE TOWN OF MAYFIELD. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON POSTING AND AFTER FINAL PASSAGE.

WHEREAS: The Planning Commission and Town Council has deemed it necessary to make the following changes to Ordinance 10-5-6-3 #6B

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Town Council of Mayfield Town, Utah

## 18.32.030. #F2 and 18.040.030 C#2 are hereby amended to read as follows:

The total number of animals or fowl kept on any lot shall not exceed five (5) animal units (See Section 18.08.020 for the complete definition; briefly, an animal unit equals one horse, one cow, four sheep, four goats, twenty chickens, thirty rabbits.) 29,000 square feet shall be required for the first animal unit and a minimum of 20,000 square feet shall be required for each additional animal unit.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon posting and passage.
