

RESOLUTION 2021-H

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING CULINARY WATER RATES

WHEREAS, the Mayfield Town Council is obligated to continue to meet payment obligations and to better maintain our culinary water system for the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.

WHEREAS, the Mayfield Town Council finds that the wells need to be pumped more due to the lower volume of water produced by its springs, creating an increase in cost to provide safe drinking water to its residents.

WHEREAS, the Mayfield Town Council has the authority to adopt this resolution pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 10-3-717 and Mayfield Code 13.04.080 and thereby exercise its legislative powers in doing so.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MAYFIELD TOWN, STATE OF UTAH AS FOLLOWS:




