Each household received a letter from the town regarding water cross connections. We are required to identify each property that uses culinary water connected to a sprinkler system. It is legal and acceptable to culinary water in an irrigation system provided there is a certified backflow preventer in place to prevent water from being syphoned back into the culinary water lines. Please follow the instruction in the letter. Let us know if you have any questions.

The Council approved a tax rate of .001244, which is in the middle of the cities in Sanpete County. We realize this is a significant jump for this year. Going forward we would like to hold a Truth in Taxation meeting more often than every 12 years, so any changes are not so significant.
